### ZOE ELLERY - MUSCULAR DYSTROPHY

We are incredibly proud of Year 5 student Zoe Ellery, as she raises both money and awareness for muscular dystrophy.

Hi, my name is Zoe (in the middle of the photo!). I am 10 years old, and have been at Woodbury School since I was 5. When I was 6 years old, I was diagnosed with muscular dystrophy. This is quite rare for girls my age, and normally girls my age don't show the symptoms I have. This affects mainly my calf muscles which can get really sore after running and other activity. Other muscles in my body can also be affected. To help I have some cream and oils which help. I can still do sports and other activities, I just need to take it easy! I am trying to raise money which will go towards research to help other people who have muscular dystrophy. Thank you to anyone who donates!








Oriental Lilies Bag of four lily bulbs For \$(1-00) The roots form from the top of bulb which should be planted 10cm deep.
